With version 2.01 released in 1984, AutoCAD began to be sold through software distribution channels. Version 2.03 in 1986 enabled AutoCAD to export and import DXF files, which is the standard for most CAD software. The first true version of AutoCAD, 2.01 (released in 1986), allowed users to drag blocks (3D primitives) around in a geometric space and move the blocks and associated dimensions around, creating objects and dimensional drawings. It is one of the earliest true CAD programs, and made it simple for architects, engineers, and draftsman to share their creations. AutoCAD 360 was released in 1998. It consisted of the desktop application plus a workbench and associated tools and utilities that were separate from the AutoCAD interface. The workbench contained an array of tools and utilities to make the installation of the AutoCAD client easier. AutoCAD 3D for Windows was released in 2000 and AutoCAD 3D for Mac in 2004. Autodesk now markets the AutoCAD product through software distribution channels. In 2001, the software was released as Autodesk Inventor and Autodesk 3ds Max. In March 2004, Autodesk launched AutoCAD Architecture, a version of AutoCAD designed specifically for architecture. AutoCAD LT (Legacy AutoCAD) was released in 2008 to bring the application to the widest possible base of users, including those who could not afford or use AutoCAD. The 2007 release of AutoCAD and AutoCAD LT coincided with the release of AutoCAD 2007. The first mobile version of AutoCAD was introduced in 2002. AutoCAD 360 Mobile was released in 2008 as a way to access the functions of the AutoCAD Workbench on a mobile device. Since then, many of AutoCAD's mobile products have been introduced. AutoCAD Mobile and AutoCAD Mobile LT are mobile versions of AutoCAD and AutoCAD LT respectively. AutoCAD Web Apps, released in 2010, is the web interface for AutoCAD, AutoCAD LT, and AutoCAD Architecture. AutoCAD Mobile App is a native iOS app that provides AutoCAD mobile capabilities such as access to user drawings and editing

2010–11 Princeton Tigers men's basketball team The 2010–11 Princeton Tigers men's basketball team represented Princeton University in intercollegiate basketball during the 2010–11 NCAA Division I men's basketball season. The head coach was the Hall of Fame coach Bill Carmody, who was in his 40th season as Princeton's head coach. The team played its home games in the Jadwin Gymnasium on the University campus in Princeton, New Jersey, and was a member of the Ivy League. The team finished the season with an 18–15 overall record, and a 7–9 record in Ivy League play, finishing in fifth place. The team finished tied for fifth place in the Ivy League. The team's record of 5–4 in Ivy League games was the program's best since the 2000–01 team, and its first winning conference record since the 2005–06 season.
